No God, No Peace ~ Know God, Know Peace

There are many verses in scripture where peace is mentioned. One of the most quoted is **John 14:27**.

"Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid."

The way peace is emphasized in this verse, by using the word "My", makes it seem like more than just a mood or a feeling. It seems like an actual gift or possession.
