As You Get Ready Each Day, Don't Forget to "Put on Love"

As Christians we know there is a lot that the Bible says about "Love." The word "Love" appears several hundred times in the English translation of the Bible. We hear sermons and sing songs about God's Love. At weddings we often hear 1st Corinthians chapter 13 being quoted. We teach our children Memory Verses about God's Love ~ in fact, Ms. Sherry is teaching her class to say *"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind and with all your strength."*

But what does showing God's Love look like in our daily lives? Sometimes it might look like a grand, expensive gesture, a sacrifice of time or money. Other times it can be rather ordinary and simple, such as a friendly smile, an out-stretched hand, a listening ear.
